

PEOPLE WITH DISABILITIES IN UZBEKISTAN ARE UNDER THE PROTECTION OF THE LAW

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Abstract

The article talks about the work being done for the education of children with disabilities, inclusive education and the adopted law on this education, as well as the current problems and shortcomings in this regard.

The main goal is the glorification of a person, the expression of his rights and his legitimate interests, as well as the comprehensive perfection.

In Uzbekistan, people with disabilities are valued and legally protected as equal members of society. According to data, now the number of people with disabilities all over the world is about 1 billion, of which about 700 thousand are in our country.

The Universal Declaration of Human Rights, adopted in Paris on December 10, 1948, so far remains one of the most important and fundamental laws on human rights, while Uzbekistan, along with hundreds of countries, serves as the basis for this declaration in the creation of human rights legislation.

The most basic human rights legislation in Uzbekistan is the state Constitution of the Republic of Uzbekistan. Second chapter of the Constitution,

Chapter 5, Article 18 confirms that all citizens of Uzbekistan have equal rights and freedoms regardless of nationality, religion, race. This article in turn also guarantees the protection of the freedoms of people with disabilities. Currently, persons with disabilities are freely operating in all areas. There are no restrictions on them. Chapter 6, Article 24, however, is legally protected that every person has the right to life. It is guaranteed that a person has the right to find his place in society, no matter what, to live in spite of his mental or physical capacity. In fact, our society is a multinational people, nevertheless all equal and able to move freely in any area. Chapter 9, Article 40 everyone has the right to free and quality medical care. In our country, the execution of this article is at a high level. State medical hospitals have organized free examinations and issuance of medicines, special technical means for people with disabilities. Certain discounts are also installed in private medical centers. Even, medical technical means are being distributed by the state. Chapter 9, Article 41 everyone has the right to knowledge. Free general education is guaranteed by the state. General secondary education in our country is free of charge and its financial costs are covered by the state. In recent years, very effective work has been carried out to improve the quality of Education. The fact that 2023 in Uzbekistan is declared the year of “attention to Man and quality education” is also proof of our word. Huge

reforms are expected in the education system this year. Children with disabilities in our country not only study general secondary education for free, but also continue their education on the basis of state grants.

Chapter 10 of the Constitution, Article 45 the rights of minors, the incapacitated and the lonely elderly are under state protection. In our country, minors, those with disabilities and the elderly are appreciated. Certain benefits are provided in the socio-household spheres. We can see this as a practical example of the fact that 2007 was declared the year of "Social Protection". Chapter Three, Chapter 14, Article 64 parents are obliged to feed and educate their children until they reach adulthood. The reason for our national human values and humanism is that a child with no disabilities is left unattended.

In order to strengthen social protection under the leadership of the president of Uzbekistan, many good deeds have been carried out on the provision of subsidized housing for women with disabilities and those who have lost their breadwinner, children left without care, employment of the unemployed.

Our President Sh.M. On February 22, 2021, in a speech at the 46th session of the UN Human Rights Council, Mirziyoyev made a proposal to create a Regional Council on issues of full realization of the abilities of persons with disabilities and noted that in Uzbekistan serious attention is paid to ensuring the rights of persons with special needs.

The law on the rights of Persons With Disabilities of the Republic of Uzbekistan was adopted by the Legislative Chamber of the Republic of Uzbekistan on July 22, 2020 and approved by the Senate on September 11, 2020, signed by the president of our state on October 15. In this law, important issues such as non-discrimination of people with disabilities by their appearance, equality in social life, logistical protection and security are guaranteed. It should be noted that in our country, issues of human dignity, especially persons with disabilities, are constantly paying close attention and certain work is being carried out to protect their rights and interests. Indeed, people with disabilities in our state have medical and pedagogical, cultural-household, economic-social benefits. Benefits up to 30, 50, 100 percent are created, depending on the level of opportunity. Article 4 of the law provides for non-discrimination of persons with disabilities, dignity, Article 18 guarantees equality, Article 27 provides for cultural recreation, Article 32 provides for rehabilitation and Abilitation, Article 36 provides for social assistance, Article 38 provides for educational benefits, Article 42 provides for the procedure for paying for cocktails.

The labor code and tax code of the Republic of Uzbekistan also establishes that the payment of Disabled Persons of the I-II group with disabilities and holidays should not be less than 48 working days. This will serve to maintain the material condition of persons with disabilities who do not have an additional bonus of vacation time. Social assistance and protection of people with disabilities, creation of the necessary conditions for their free activities, Organization of society of people with various categories of disabilities, cultural leisure, acquisition of knowledge and organization of electronic libraries, information resource centers, provision of special equipment and facilities, creation of medical and pedagogical, Road Transport benefits is a political topic before the state.

Today, about 600 non-profit organizations operate in the field of disability in our country. Among them are such NGOs as the disabled Society of Uzbekistan, the disabled fund of

Uzbekistan, the National Association of business women with disabilities of Uzbekistan, the Center for youth and children with disabilities, the public Center “Umr”, the public Association of disabled people “inclusive life”, the Society of persons with visual and hearing disabilities. These organizations are engaged in ensuring equality, freedom in society, adaptation and their protection and comprehensive assistance to persons with disabilities. Under each society, shops and enterprises are organized that prepare small, sewing, buttons, plasmas, which not only provide jobs for people with disabilities, but also carry out their intervention and adaptation to society.

People with disabilities are also equal members of society. infringement of their rights, or restriction of their freedoms, discrimination is absolutely prohibited. Therefore, we should not see them inferior to us and, if we can, protect and help them. This is our human duty.

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
